Based in Alexandra Township, he has become a leading figure in indigenous performance art, known for his signature style, **Animalism** — a fusion of traditional Khoisan movement, contemporary dance, and embodied storytelling.

His company serves as a platform for cultural performance, heritage education, artistic collaboration, and community upliftment. Through live shows, workshops, media appearances, and international engagements, Lebo champions South Africa's ancient identity while inspiring new generations to embrace their roots.



BIOGRAPHY

Lebo's artistic journey began in **2003** with the Public Creativity Drama Krew (PKDK), where he discovered his passion for performance and cultural expression. Over the years, he expanded his craft by choreographing for dance groups and training young children in Khoisan dance traditions.

He later studied acting at the **Market Theatre**, earning a drama certificate in dance — a foundation that strengthened his stage presence, movement vocabulary, and storytelling ability.

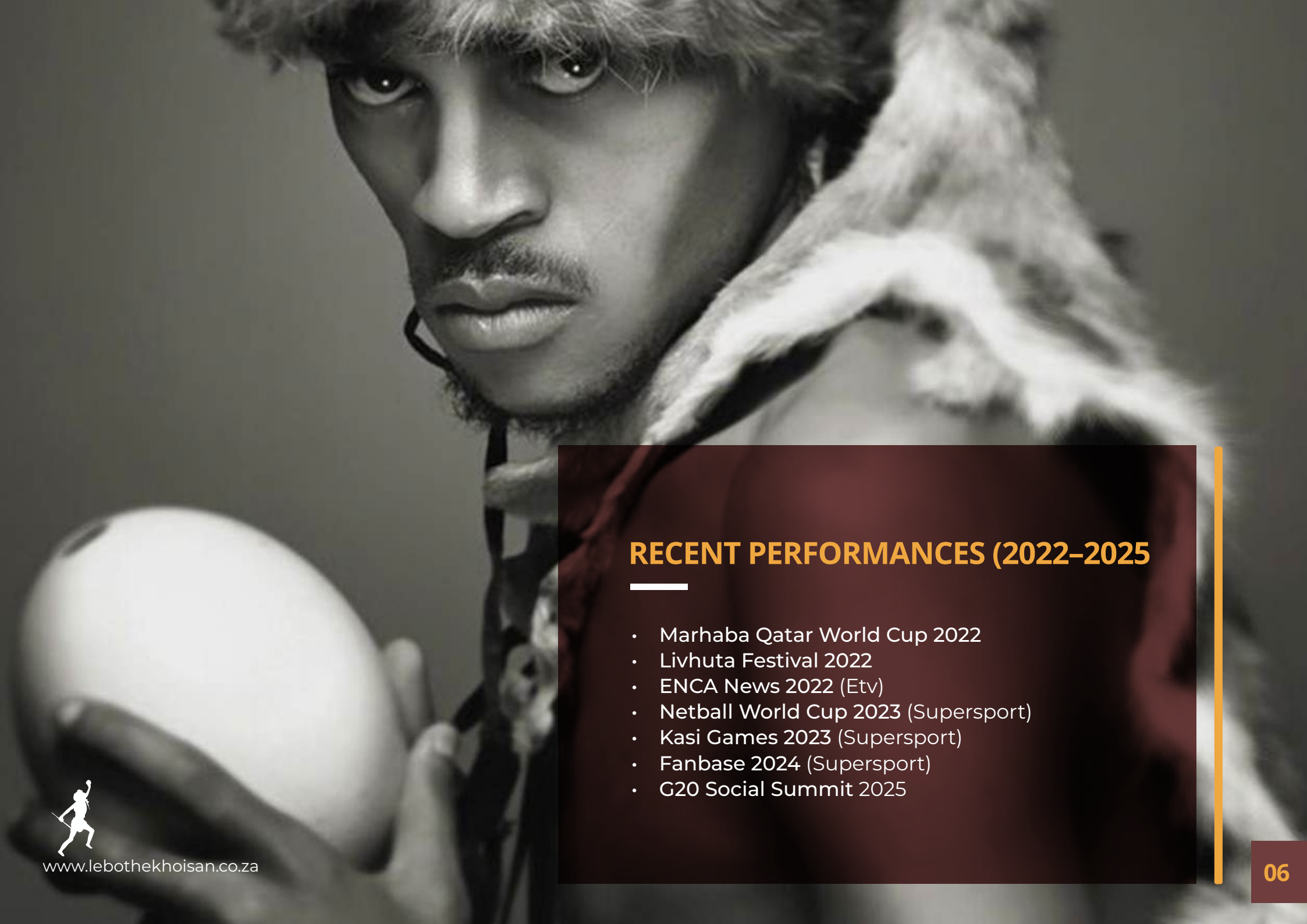
